

SUMMARY OF DECISIONS RENDERED BY THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION ON JANUARY 19 and FEBRUARY 2, 2010 REGARDING BOUNDARY REALIGNMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

GROUP I

Boundary Realignment for the Funkstown Attendance Zone – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Reassign Pre-K and K students residing in the existing Eastern Elementary School attendance zone from the Funkstown School for Early Childhood Education to Eastern Primary School, which will reassign approximately 125 students and will be effective August 2011.

Boundary Realignment Description O.2 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Establish a portion of the attendance zone for the Eastern Primary/Eastern Elementary School Complex, known as Boundary Realignment O.2 and generally described as the northern portion of the Winter Street Elementary School attendance zone as defined by the existing Salem Avenue Elementary School attendance zone to the west, the railroad tracks to the north and the east and Salem Avenue to the south, which will reassign approximately 100 Winter Street Elementary students to the Eastern Complex and will be effective August 2011.

Boundary Realignment Description E.6 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Establish a portion of the attendance zone for the Eastern Primary/Eastern Elementary School Complex, known as Boundary Realignment E.6 and generally described as the northwest section of the existing Greenbrier Elementary School attendance zone including White Hall Road south of Mt. Aetna Road and north of Interstate 70 and areas west to include the Brightwood Acres East and Black Rock Estates subdivisions and a portion of Landis Road to the existing Eastern Elementary School attendance zone, which will reassign approximately 50 Greenbrier Elementary students to the Eastern Complex and will be effective August 2011.

Boundary Realignment Description F.6 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Establish a portion of the attendance zone for the Eastern Primary/Eastern Elementary School Complex, known as Boundary Realignment F.6 and generally described as the southeast portion of the existing Pangborn Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Robinwood Drive to the west, Woodbridge Drive to the north, the proposed Black Rock PUD and the existing Old

Forge Elementary School attendance zone to the east and the south, which will reassign approximately 195 Pangborn Elementary students to the Eastern Complex and will be effective 2011.

Boundary Realignment Description M.3 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Establish a portion of the attendance zone for the Eastern Primary/Eastern Elementary School Complex, known as Boundary Realignment M.3 and generally described as the southern portion of the Fountaindale Elementary School attendance zone as defined by the railroad tracks to the west, Charles Street to the north, the existing Eastern and Potomac Heights Elementary School attendance zones to the east, and the existing Bester Elementary School attendance zone to the south, which will reassign approximately 77 Fountaindale Elementary students to the Eastern Complex and will be effective 2011.

Boundary Realignment K.2 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Establish a portion of the attendance zone for the Eastern Primary/Eastern Elementary School Complex, known as Boundary Realignment K.2 and generally described as the northeastern portion of the Salem Avenue Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Arlington Avenue to the west, the railroad tracks to the north, the existing Winter Street Elementary School attendance zone to the east, and Marshall Street to the south, which will reassign approximately 26 Salem Avenue Elementary students to the Eastern Complex and will be effective 2011.

GROUP II

Boundary Realignment for the Funkstown Attendance Zone – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Reassign Pre–K students attending Bester Elementary School to the Funkstown School for Early Childhood Education attendance zone from Bester Elementary, which will reassign approximately 70 students and will be effective August 2011.

Fifth Grade Returns to Winter Street Elementary – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Return fifth grade students residing in the proposed Winter Street Elementary School attendance zone to Winter Street Elementary from Salem Avenue Elementary School, which will reassign

approximately 50 fifth grade students and will be effective August 2011 and is contingent upon Boundary Description O.2.

Boundary Realignment Description N.2 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Pangborn Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment N.2 and generally described as the southern portion of the existing Potomac Heights Elementary School attendance zone as defined by the existing Fountaindale Elementary School attendance zone to the west, Fairground Avenue to the north, the existing Pangborn Elementary attendance zone to the east, and the existing Eastern Elementary School attendance zone to the south, which will reassign approximately 101 Potomac Heights Elementary students to Pangborn Elementary and will be effective August 2011 and contingent upon Boundary Realignment F.6.

Boundary Realignment Description R.1 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Pangborn Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment R.1 and generally described as the southeast portion of the existing Paramount Elementary attendance zone as defined by Leitersburg Pike and the existing Potomac Heights Elementary School attendance zone to the west, the Cortland Manor Development to the north, the existing Pangborn Elementary attendance zone to the east and the south, which will reassign approximately 49 Paramount Elementary students to Pangborn Elementary and will be effective 2011 and contingent upon Boundary Realignment F.6.

Boundary Realignment Description Q.1 – Effective 2011

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Paramount Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment Q.1 and generally described as the eastern portion of the Maugansville Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Paradise Church Road on the west, the existing Maugansville Elementary attendance zone to the north and the east, and Long Meadow Road to the south, which will reassign approximately 124 Maugansville Elementary students to Paramount Elementary and will be effective 2011 and contingent upon Boundary Realignment R.1.

GROUP III

Boundary Realignment Description T.1 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Lincolnshire Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment T.1 and generally described as the southeastern portion of the Conococheague Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Hopewell Road to the west, the existing Salem Avenue Elementary School attendance zone to the north and the east, and the existing Lincolnshire Elementary attendance zone to the south, which will reassign approximately 30 Conococheague Elementary students to Lincolnshire Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description T.2 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Williamsport Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment T.2 and generally described as the southern portion of the Conococheague Elementary School attendance zone as defined by White Pine Drive to the west, Gardenia Court to the north, the existing Hickory Elementary School attendance zone to the east, and the Williamsport Elementary attendance zone to the south, which will reassign approximately 66 Conococheague Elementary students to Williamsport Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description T.3 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Maugansville Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment T.3 and generally described as the eastern portion of the Conococheague Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Resh Road to the west, and the existing Maugansville Elementary attendance zone on all other sides, which will reassign approximately 15 Conococheague Elementary students to Maugansville Elementary and will be effective August 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description P.1 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Lincolnshire Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment P.1 and generally described as the southern portion of the Winter Street Elementary School attendance zone as defined by the railroad tracks to the north, the existing Bester Elementary School attendance zone to the east, and the existing Lincolnshire Elementary attendance zone to the south and the west, which will reassign approximately 34 Winter Street Elementary students to Lincolnshire Elementary and will be effective 2010.

GROUP IV

Boundary Realignment Description A.3 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Cascade Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment A.3 and generally described as the northeastern most portion of the existing Old Forge Elementary School attendance zone to include the area from both sides of Route 64 east to the current Cascade Elementary boundary and bordered on the south by the existing Smithsburg Elementary School attendance zone, which will reassign approximately 90 Old Forge Elementary students to Cascade Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description C.1 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Old Forge Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment C.1 and generally described as the northern section of the existing Greenbrier Elementary School attendance zone currently assigned to Smithsburg Middle and High Schools and bordered by Frederick County to the east, White Hall Road to the west, Mount Aetna and connecting roads to the south and the existing Smithsburg Elementary School attendance zone to the north, which will reassign approximately 50 Greenbrier Elementary students to Old Forge Elementary and will be effective 2010 and is contingent upon Boundary Description A.3.

GROUP V

Boundary Realignment Description L.1 – Effective 2010

Enlarge the Fountain Rock Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment L.1 and generally described as the northern portion of the existing Sharpsburg Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Mansfield Road, to Mansfield Avenue to Mondell Road to Powell Road to the south, which will reassign approximately 28 Sharpsburg Elementary students to Fountain Rock Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description J.1 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Fountain Rock Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment J.1 and generally described as the northwest portion of the existing Rockland Woods Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Interstate Route 70 on the north, the

railroad tracks on the east, Rench Road and the Pleasant View Heights Subdivision south to the intersection of Downsville Pike and Lappans Road (MD 68) and the existing Williamsport Elementary School attendance zone to the west, which will reassign approximately 18 Rockland Woods Elementary students to Fountain Rock Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description J.2 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Fountain Rock Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment J.2 and generally described as the western portion of the existing Rockland Woods Elementary School attendance zone as defined by Reichard Road, Spielman Road and Fairplay Road on the east, which will reassign approximately 16 Rockland Woods Elementary students to Fountain Rock Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description G.2 – Effective 2010

Approved 1/19/2010

Enlarge the Rockland Woods Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment G.2 and generally described as the northwest section of the existing Boonsboro Elementary School attendance zone from Millpoint Road and Manor Church Road to the existing Rockland Woods Elementary eastern attendance boundary, which will reassign approximately 42 Boonsboro Elementary students to Rockland Woods Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description G.3 – Effective 2010

Enlarge the Rockland Woods Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment G.3 and generally described as an area encompassing Wheeler Road, Osage Drive, and Girl Scout Road bordered by but not including Manor Church Road to the north, the existing Boonsboro Elementary School attendance zone to the east and the south and the existing Sharpsburg Elementary School attendance zone to the west, which will reassign approximately 4 Boonsboro Elementary students to Rockland Woods Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Boundary Realignment Description V.1 – Effective 2010

Approved 2/2/2010

Enlarge the Pleasant Valley Elementary School attendance zone, known as Boundary Realignment V.1 and generally defined by Marble Quarry Road, the Windsor Farm subdivision and Reno Monument Road to the north, the Frederick County Boundary to the east, the existing Pleasant Valley Elementary attendance zone to the south and the Sharpsburg Elementary School

attendance zone to the west, which will reassign approximately 28 Boonsboro Elementary students to Pleasant Valley Elementary and will be effective 2010.

Motion to Address Special Permission for Rising Fifth Graders for 2010-2011 School Year

Approved 1/19/2010

Rising 5th grade students in the affected redistricting plan for year 2010-2011 school year in the affected schools be granted special permission if applied for by the parent or guardian provided that the parent or guardian provide transportation to the school where special permission is granted.

Motion to Address Special Permission for Rising Fifth Graders for 2011-2012 School Year

Approved 2/2/2010

Rising 5th grade students in the affected redistricting plan for year 2011-2012 school year in the affected schools be granted special permission if applied for by the parent or guardian provided that the parent or guardian provide transportation to the school where special permission is granted.

Motion Establishing Deadline to File Application for Special Permission Pertaining to Rising 5th Graders Affected by Attendance Zone Realignment for 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 School Years

Approved 2/2/2010

The application for special permission for rising 5th grade students who are affected by the redistricting plan in the 2010-2011 school year or the 2011-2012 school year must be filed by the parent or guardian by April 1st of the respective school year with the Department of Student Services.
